These little gems were a fun and easy way to reward good behavior and discourage the bad. I created a page of paper money called Behavior Bucks. They were very simple:



I made them using Microsoft Publisher. I created a table with 2 columns and 6 rows. I put what I wanted inside the box and copied it to all the others. This could be expanded for any other idea, it was just what came together quickly for me.

I printed out a few pages, cut them up and got a box to store them in. When I caught my daughter being good (she was 4 at the time) I'd reward her with a buck that she could put in her "bank." If she got in trouble she'd have to give one or more back to me. She could earn things she wanted with the bucks she accumulated. I kept some of her favorite snacks on hand and made a few trips to the dollar store for her to "purchase" items as she earned enough. Bigger items cost more and she'd have to work harder and longer for them.
