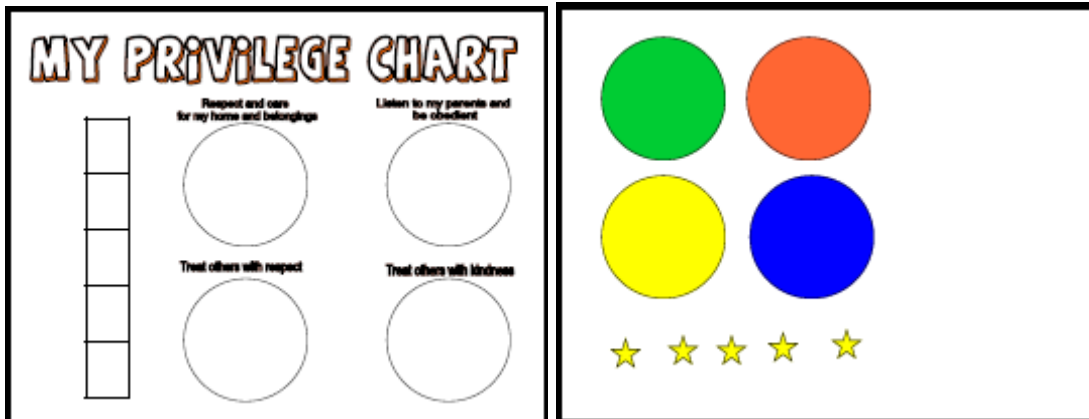


# Privilege Chart

As my daughter grew into what I'll lovingly call her "too big for my britches" phase I was met with new challenges. We'd done the [Behavior Bucks](#) and the [Privilege Magnets](#) with success but she was growing past what they could do. I needed a way to help her SEE her progress (or lack of) with specific behaviors that were becoming a problem. So I created a new chart and system for her.



I printed the chart on cardstock, cut out the colored circles and attached them to the back of the chart with brads. I cut a slit in the circles so the colored circle could "fill" the white circle. This way I could adjust the behavior success with corresponding amounts to her actions. When she got a circle all the way filled she'd get a star on the left. I put magnet material on the backs of the stars so they could be placed on in the boxes. Together, we came up with what things she wanted as rewards. They were things like "play date with a friend", "trip to McDonald's", and "trip to Chuck E Cheese", etc.

The advantage of this system was it took learning and seeing her behavior to a new level. It got me through age 6, and that's saying a whole lot!
